At Radnor High School, our scholars immerse themselves in innovative and advanced classes, such as AP Environmental Science, AP Computer Science, Civil Engineering and Architecture, Principles of Biomedicine, and Video Production and Broadcast Journalism. They actively engage in extracurricular activities, including the National Honor Society, football, basketball, track, crew, orchestra, color guard, and theater. 
